2. No out-of-school suspensions. No more than 2 office referrals.	

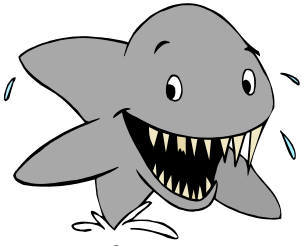
III. Service: Must earn a total of **20** hours of volunteer hours. This requirement may be met by NHMS Service (on-campus) and/or Community Service (off-campus).

NIGUEL HILLS AWARD “SHARK PRIDE”

PURPOSE

The purpose of this annual award is to recognize students who demonstrate outstanding Scholarship, Citizenship, and Service.

REQUIREMENTS

Scholarship	2.75 GPA or above during 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd quarters and no Ds or Fs on any report card.
Citizenship	No N or U on any report card. No out of school suspensions. No more than two office referrals for any reason.
Service	Students must earn a total of 20 volunteer hours. This can be NHMS service (on campus) and/or community service (off campus). <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. NHMS Service (on campus) ideas: collecting goods, helping with canned food drives, clothing collection for needy, hospitality, tutoring, helping at registration, PTSA/Booster activities and campus clean-up projects are some suggestions.2. Community Service (off campus) ideas: this might include volunteering in a public library or elementary school, working with a community or a religious organization, beach clean-up day, etc.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Students are responsible for maintaining their own records and **filling out and completing their own paperwork.**
- All service must be documented appropriately. Attach additional verification, if necessary.
- Retain a copy of the paperwork for your records.

Due Date: April 18, 2023. The completed paperwork is to be turned in, by the student, at the school office. Students will be ineligible for the award if their paperwork is not turned in by the deadline.
